Flashlights, batteries

Battery operated radio and/or TV

Cash

Keys

Books and games

Important documents—In waterproof container

Insurance

Medical records

Bank account numbers

Social security card, license

Tools

Fill vehicle gas tanks

Pet car items

Leash, muzzle,

Carrier or cage

Plenty of food and water
