Wondering what to do with that leftover oil based paint, used motor oil, fluorescent light bulbs, pesticides or old batteries?

Well there are two places you can take them to be safely and properly disposed of. On the First Saturday of every month from 8AM to

4PM, you can go to the North Wake Landfill, 9016 Deponie Dr. in Raleigh. On the Third Saturday of every month you can take things to The South Wake Multi-Material Recycling Facility at 6000 Old Smithfield Rd. in Apex (just off Rte 55) from 7AM to 3PM.
